Mowing Program

The Sussex Conservation District has a New Holland articulated tractor, hydrostatic transmission, 100 horse power engine equipped with a 60" Alamo rotary head cutter with approximately a 20 ft. reach. The second mower is a TN55 New Holland that is used to maintain tax and private ditch banks and rights-of-way, open spaces, edges of fields or property lines to control vegetative growth. With the implementation of a mowing schedule, rights-of-way remain clear of trees and saplings making them easily and quickly accessible.
