



FY 2022 State and County Matching Funds (3921) Fact Sheet

The Sussex Conservation District administers funds from the State of Delaware and Sussex County to assist tax ditch organizations with costs associated with maintaining the county's tax ditch systems. The FY 2022 General Guidelines are approved by the SCD Board of Supervisors. **SCD Board of Supervisors reserve the right to adjust payment rates and caps based on funding availability and interest in the program.**

Practices

Type of practices eligible for cost-share funds are:

- Maintenance projects are 50% of **total cost** not to exceed \$15,000:
 - ❖ Clean out ditch channels and spread spoil
 - ❖ Pipe crossing repairs/replacements
 - ❖ New pipe crossings
 - ❖ Erosion repair
 - ❖ Beaver dam removal
- Mowing of tax ditch right-of-ways – \$25 per mile
- Weed Wiper Bar – 50% of total cost not to exceed \$8,000
- Hand Spraying – 50% of total cost not to exceed \$5,000
- Bonding of Secretary-Treasurer – 50% of the cost not to exceed \$150

Due to COVID-19 Restrictions, please call the office to apply for cost-share assistance. We will take your information over the phone and mail the application for your signature.

All applications will be ranked based on severity of problem, actively maintained rights-of-way, invasive species, etc.

Application Process & Eligibility

Applications will be received at the Sussex Conservation District office located in the USDA Service Center at 21315 Berlin Road, Unit 4, Georgetown, Delaware from **June 14, 2021 through July 30, 2021**. **An estimate for proposed maintenance work is needed at time of application.** Once applications are received, they will be ranked and presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval. After approval, letters will be sent to every applicant notifying of approval or denial. If denied, the reason will be explained in the letter.

Requirements for eligibility:

- Because of COVID-19 restrictions, an annual meeting had to take place within the previous 24 months, and the minutes must be submitted to the Div. of Watershed Stewardship – Drainage Section by July 1, 2021.
- **An audited financial statement must be submitted to the Division of Watershed Stewardship – Drainage Section by JULY 1, 2021. NOTICE NEW DEADLINE OF JULY 1, 2021!**

Construction Process

Applicant has ten months to begin construction from the cost-share approval date with the possibility of one 30-day extension that must be granted by the District Coordinator. **Funds approved for projects not completed in 24 months will expire.**
